CONCERNING THE COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION METHOD USED BY THE
STATEWIDE INTERNET PORTAL AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT FOR A
STATEWIDE PORTAL INTEGRATOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:


SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-37.7-104, **amend**
(2) as follows:

24-37.7-104. Powers of the statewide internet portal authority.
(2) The authority shall not enter into a contract with a statewide portal
integrator unless the statewide portal integrator was chosen by the authority
pursuant to a request for proposals OR OTHER COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT
METHOD, INCLUDING AN INVITATION TO NEGOTIATE, issued by the authority.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
