## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Business Affairs and Labor.HB18-1184 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and  
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 40-2-130 as  
4 follows:

5 **40-2-130. State of 911 report.** (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION  
6 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 15, 2018, AND ON OR  
7 BEFORE SEPTEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION  
8 SHALL PUBLISH A "STATE OF 911" REPORT AND SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE  
9 MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. THE REPORT MUST PROVIDE AN  
10 OVERALL UNDERSTANDING OF THE STATE OF 911 SERVICE IN COLORADO  
11 AND MUST ADDRESS, AT A MINIMUM, THE FOLLOWING:

12 (a) THE COMMISSION'S ACTIONS RELATED TO 911 SERVICE IN THE  
13 STATE DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR AS WELL AS PLANNED  
14 IMPLEMENTATION ACTIONS RELATED TO 911 SERVICE FOR THE UPCOMING  
15 YEAR;

16 (b) THE CURRENT STATEWIDE STRUCTURE, TECHNOLOGY, AND  
17 GENERAL OPERATIONS OF 911 SERVICE IN COLORADO;

18 (c) 911 NETWORK RELIABILITY AND RESILIENCY;

19 (d) IDENTIFIED GAPS, VULNERABILITIES, AND NEEDS RELATED TO  
20 911 SERVICE IN THE STATE;

21 (e) THE IMPACT ON AND INVOLVEMENT OF THE STATE IN FEDERAL  
22 ACTIVITIES AND NATIONAL TRENDS AFFECTING 911 SERVICE IN  
23 COLORADO;

24 (f) THE STATE'S PLANNING FOR, TRANSITION TO, AND  
25 IMPLEMENTATION OF NEXT GENERATION 911, INCLUDING A PROJECTED  
26 TIMELINE FOR FULL STATEWIDE IMPLEMENTATION; AND

27 (g) A DISCUSSION OF 911 FUNDING AND FISCAL OUTLOOK,  
28 INCLUDING CURRENT FUNDING SOURCES AND WHETHER THEY ARE  
29 ADEQUATE FOR 911 SERVICE IN THE STATE, AND POTENTIAL FUNDING  
30 MECHANISMS FOR THE TRANSITION TO AND IMPLEMENTATION OF NEXT  
31 GENERATION 911.

32 (2) IN DEVELOPING THE REPORT EACH YEAR, THE COMMISSION  
33 SHALL CONSULT WITH PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS AS DEFINED IN  
34 SECTION 29-11-101 (6.5), 911 GOVERNING BODIES AS DEFINED IN SECTION  
35 29-11-101 (4), AND STATEWIDE ORGANIZATIONS THAT REPRESENT PUBLIC  
36 SAFETY AGENCIES.

37 (3) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2019, AND ON OR BEFORE  
38 FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION SHALL  
39 PRESENT THE REPORT TO THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS, LABOR,  
40 AND TECHNOLOGY, OR ITS SUCCESSOR COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE OF

1 REPRESENTATIVES COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AFFAIRS AND LABOR OR ITS  
2 SUCCESSOR COMMITTEE.

3 (4) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO GRANT  
4 THE COMMISSION THE AUTHORITY TO REGULATE ANY PROVIDERS OR  
5 SERVICES EXEMPT FROM JURISDICTION UNDER SECTION 40-15-401.

6 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
7 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
8 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

9 Page 1, strike lines 101 through 102 and substitute "**CONCERNING A**  
10 **REQUIREMENT FOR THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO REPORT**  
11 **ANNUALLY TO THE LEGISLATURE REGARDING THE STATE OF 911**  
12 **SERVICE IN COLORADO.**".

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
