HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT Committee on Judiciary.

SB19-027 be amended as follows:

Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, strike lines 22 through 25 and substitute "to be buried GIVEN FINAL DISPOSITION at public expense shall:

- (a) Use reasonable effort to ascertain if the deceased person has any relative, friend, or other representative who will assume charge of the body for burial FINAL DISPOSITION at his or her THE CLAIMANT'S expense;
- (b) If the effort does not result in the discovery of a claimant within twenty-four hours after death, the officers, agents, or other persons shall A REASONABLE TIME AND IF THE ANATOMICAL BOARD DOES NOT ACCEPT THE BODY, PROCEED WITH FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE BODY;
- (c) Immediately notify the anatomical board or such THE person as may from time to time be THAT IS designated by the board as its duly authorized officer or agent; AND
- (d) when such unclaimed body or bodies come into his or her possession, charge, or control. In any county that is entirely located more than one hundred fifty miles from any accredited medical or dental school, the minimum period of notification shall be extended to forty-eight hours. The officers, agents, or other persons, without fee or reward, shall IF THE EFFORT DOES NOT RESULT IN THE DISCOVERY OF A CLAIMANT AND THE BOARD ACCEPTS THE BODY, deliver the unclaimed body, WITHOUT FEE OR REWARD, to the anatomical board and permit the board or its agents AGENT to take and remove all the unclaimed bodies BODY to be used for the advancement of medical and anatomical sciences."
