FIRST REPORT OF FIRST CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
ON SB19-217

THIS REPORT AMENDS THE
REREVISED BILL

To the President of the Senate and the
Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Your first conference committee appointed on SB19-217, concerning healthcare provider liens related to charges for medical care provided to a person injured as a result of the negligence or wrongful acts of another person, has met and reports that it has agreed upon the following:

That the Senate accede to the House amendments made to the bill, as the amendments appear in the rerevised version, with the following changes:

Amend rerevised bill, page 8, after line 15 insert:

"(2) EXCEPT IN AN ACTION UNDER THE "UNIFORM CONSUMER CREDIT CODE", ARTICLES 1 TO 9 OF TITLE 5, AN INJURED PERSON WHO RECEIVES MEDICAL TREATMENT THROUGH A HEALTHCARE PROVIDER LIEN SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME EVIDENTIARY PROTECTIONS IN ANY THIRD-PARTY OR FIRST-PARTY ACTION AS THOSE INJURED PERSONS WHO

RECEIVE MEDICAL TREATMENT THROUGH PRIVATE OR
GOVERNMENT-FUNDED HEALTH INSURANCE.".

Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.
