 - (I) MEANS ANY TYPE OF DISCARDED OR WASTE MATERIAL THAT IS NOT REGULATED UNDER SECTION 25-8-205 (1)(e) AND CAN BE REUSED, REMANUFACTURED, RECLAIMED, OR RECYCLED, INCLUDING COMPOSTABLE ORGANIC MATERIAL AND CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION MATERIALS; AND
 - (II) DOES NOT INCLUDE INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS, PAINT, OR A WASTE TIRE AS DEFINED IN SECTION 30-20-1402 (12).
 - (2) THE STAKEHOLDER ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON RECYCLING IS CREATED IN THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
 - (a) TO CONDUCT A LITERATURE REVIEW OF VARIOUS POLICY CONCEPTS, INCLUDING POLICIES ENACTED OR BEING CONSIDERED IN OTHER STATES AND OTHER NATIONS RELATIVE TO POST-CONSUMER RECYCLED CONTENT REQUIREMENTS FOR PACKAGING;
 - TO REVIEW RATES AND TIME FRAMES IN WHICH (b) POST-CONSUMER RECYCLED CONTENT, INCLUDING RECYCLED PLASTIC, GLASS, STEEL, AND PAPER, MAY BE FEASIBLY REQUIRED FOR ALL PACKAGING APPLICATIONS AND MATERIALS; AND
- 32 (c) To submit a report on or before March 1, 2022, to the 33 ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF 34 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE OF 35 THE SENATE, OR TO ANY SUCCESSOR COMMITTEE, WHICH REPORT 36 INCLUDES POLICY AND LEGISLATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE 37 FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING POST-CONSUMER RECYCLED CONTENT
- 38 REQUIREMENTS FOR PACKAGING. THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE 39 RECOMMENDATIONS IN SUBJECT MATTER AREAS WHERE THE COMMITTEE

ACHIEVED CONSENSUS AND NOTE DISSENTING OPINIONS IN SUBJECT MATTER AREAS WHERE THE COMMITTEE FAILED TO ACHIEVE CONSENSUS.

- (3) On or before August 1, 2021, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives shall jointly appoint at least one member to the committee to represent each of the following stakeholder groups:
 - (a) THE DEPARTMENT;

- (b) CITIES, INCLUDING SMALL AND LARGE CITIES AND CITIES LOCATED IN URBAN AND RURAL COUNTIES;
- (c) COUNTIES, INCLUDING SMALL AND LARGE COUNTIES AND URBAN AND RURAL COUNTIES;
 - (d) MUNICIPAL COLLECTORS;
- (e) AN ENTITY IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR WASTE AND RECYCLING INDUSTRY THAT OWNS OR OPERATES A CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM AND A MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY;
- (f) A MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY OPERATOR THAT PROCESSES MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FROM CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAMS;
- (g) A COMPANY THAT PROVIDES CURBSIDE REYCLING SERVICE PURSUANT TO A MUNICIPAL CONTRACT;
 - (h) RECYCLED PLASTIC FEEDSTOCK USERS;
- (i) A TRADE ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING THE PLASTICS RECYCLING INDUSTRY;
 - (i) A RECYCLED CONTENT CERTIFICATION ORGANIZATION;
- (k) A NONPROFIT ENVIRONMENTAL ORGANIZATION THAT SPECIALIZES IN WASTE AND RECYCLING ISSUES;
 - (1) PLASTIC CONVERTERS AND MANUFACTURERS OF RESINS;
 - (m) A MANUFACTURER OF PLASTIC PACKAGING;
 - (n) A STATEWIDE BUSINESS TRADE ASSOCIATION;
- 29 (o) An association that represents consumer brand 30 companies;
 - (p) CONSUMER BRANDS;
 - (q) A CONSUMER-ORIENTED ORGANIZATION;
 - (r) A STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION OF RETAILERS; AND
 - (s) AN ADVANCED RECYCLING TECHNOLOGY PROVIDER THAT PROCESSES PLASTIC MATERIAL.
 - (4) The president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives shall jointly appoint a member of the committee to chair the committee, and on or before September 1, 2021, the chair shall convene the committee.
 - (5) IN FULFILLING ITS DUTIES UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIDER INFORMATION AND FINDINGS BY A VARIETY OF AUTHORITATIVE ENTITIES RELATED TO RECYCLABLE MATERIALS, INCLUDING ENTITIES WITH EXPERTISE CONCERNING ADVANCED RECYCLING
